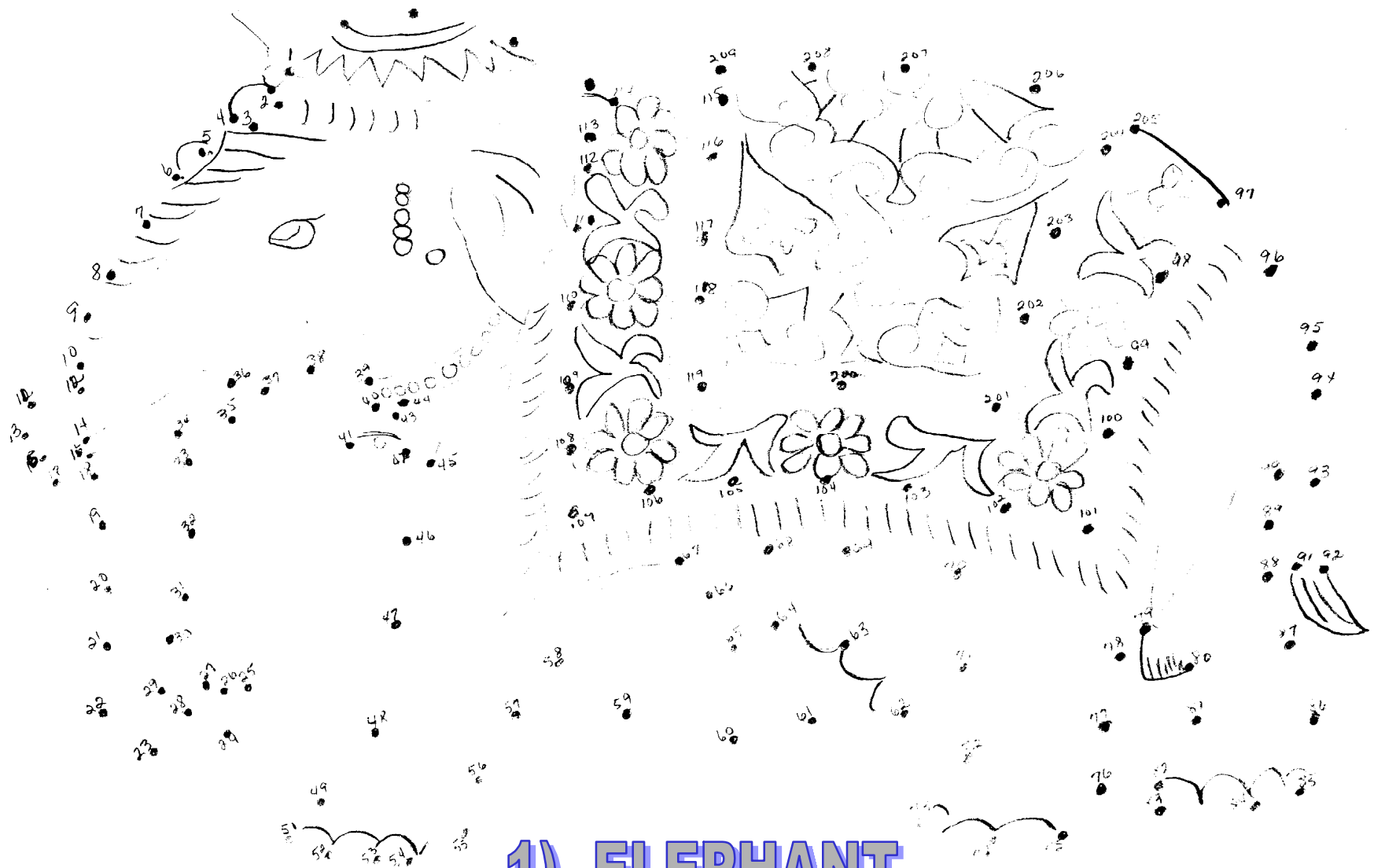
## Dreams of Mother Trishala:

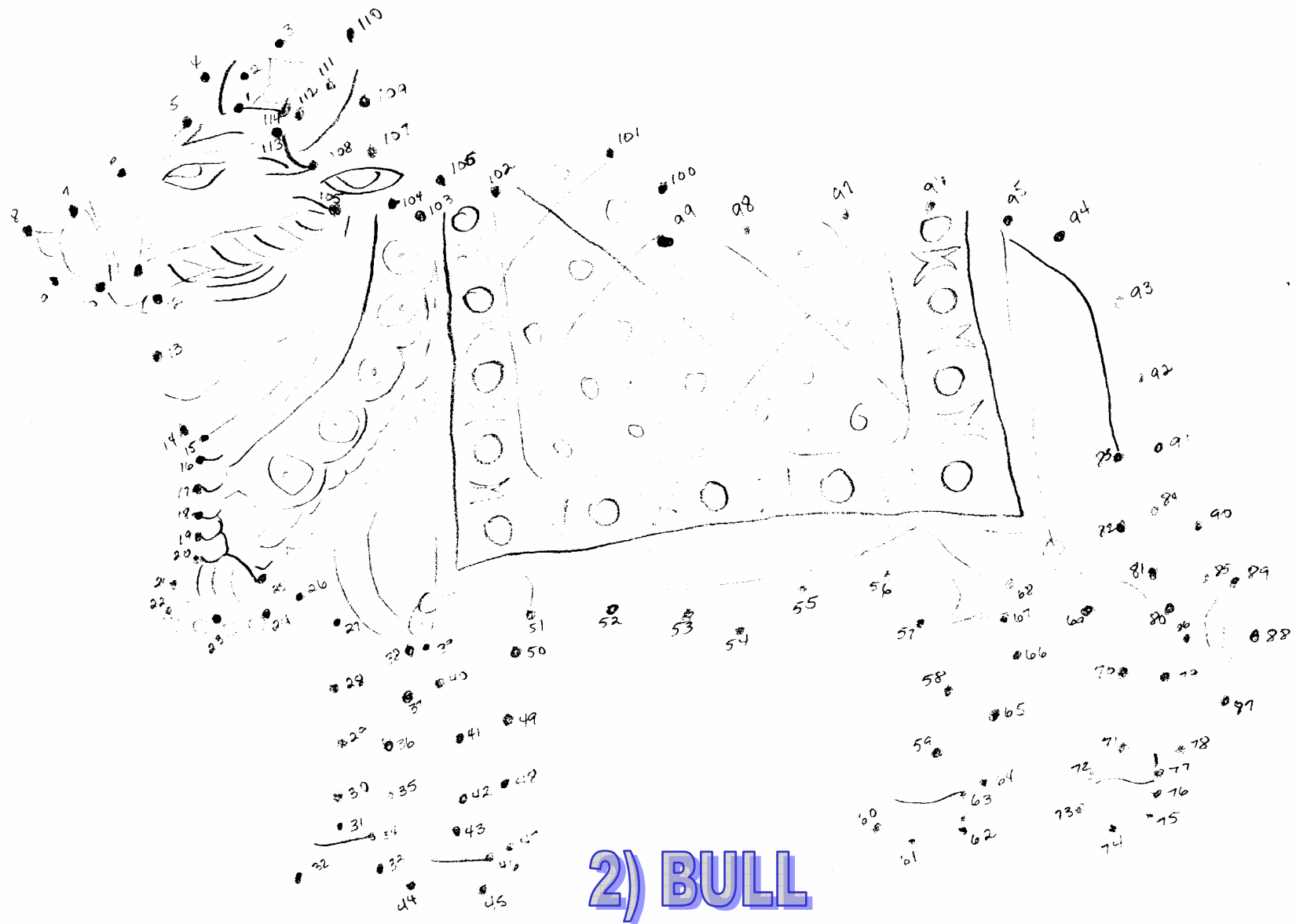
			would help the spiritual progress of entire humanity at large.

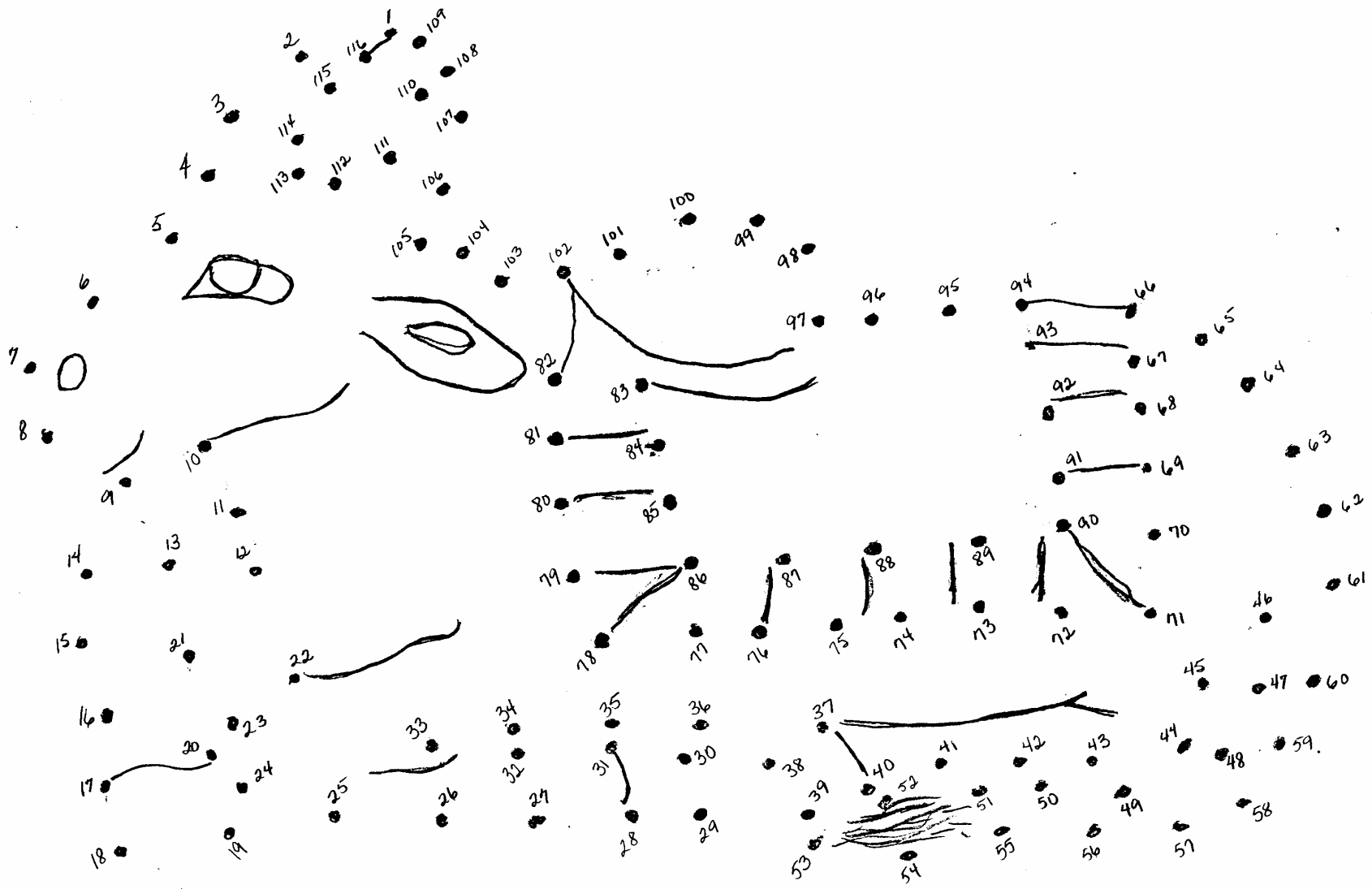
Shevatambar tradition believes that Tirthankar **Malli Nath** was a female while Digambar tradition believes that Malli Nath was a male.

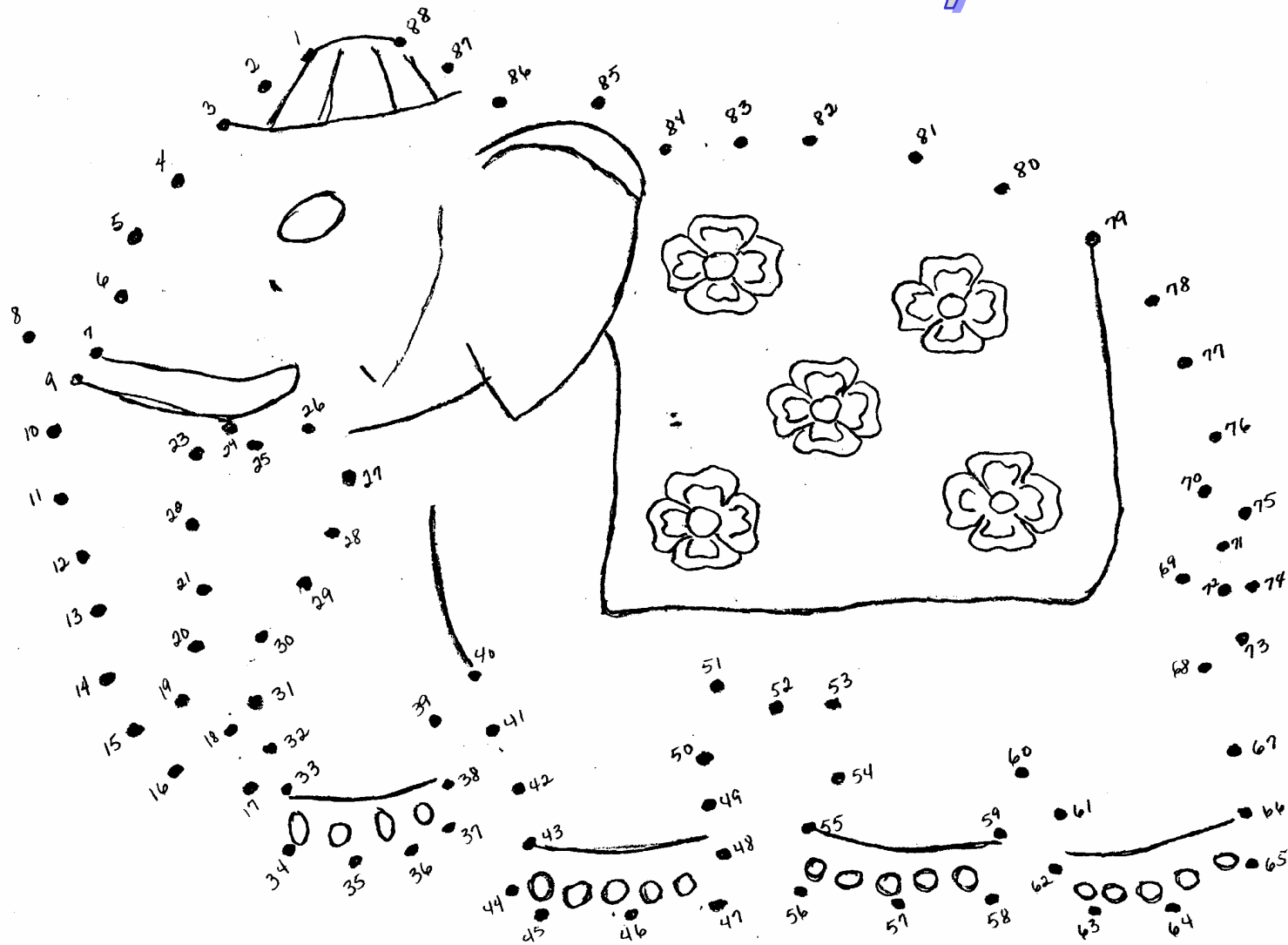
**Tirthankar Parshva Nath** was born in 877 BC He lived for 100 years and attained Nirvana 250 years before Nirvana of Bhagwan Mahavir in 777 BC

**Tirthankar Mahavir Swami** was born in 599 BC and attained Nirvan (Moksha) in 527 BC He was named Prince Vardhamana at birth. He attained Nirvana on the day of Diwali. He is the last of the series 24 Tirthanakaras of this time cycle.



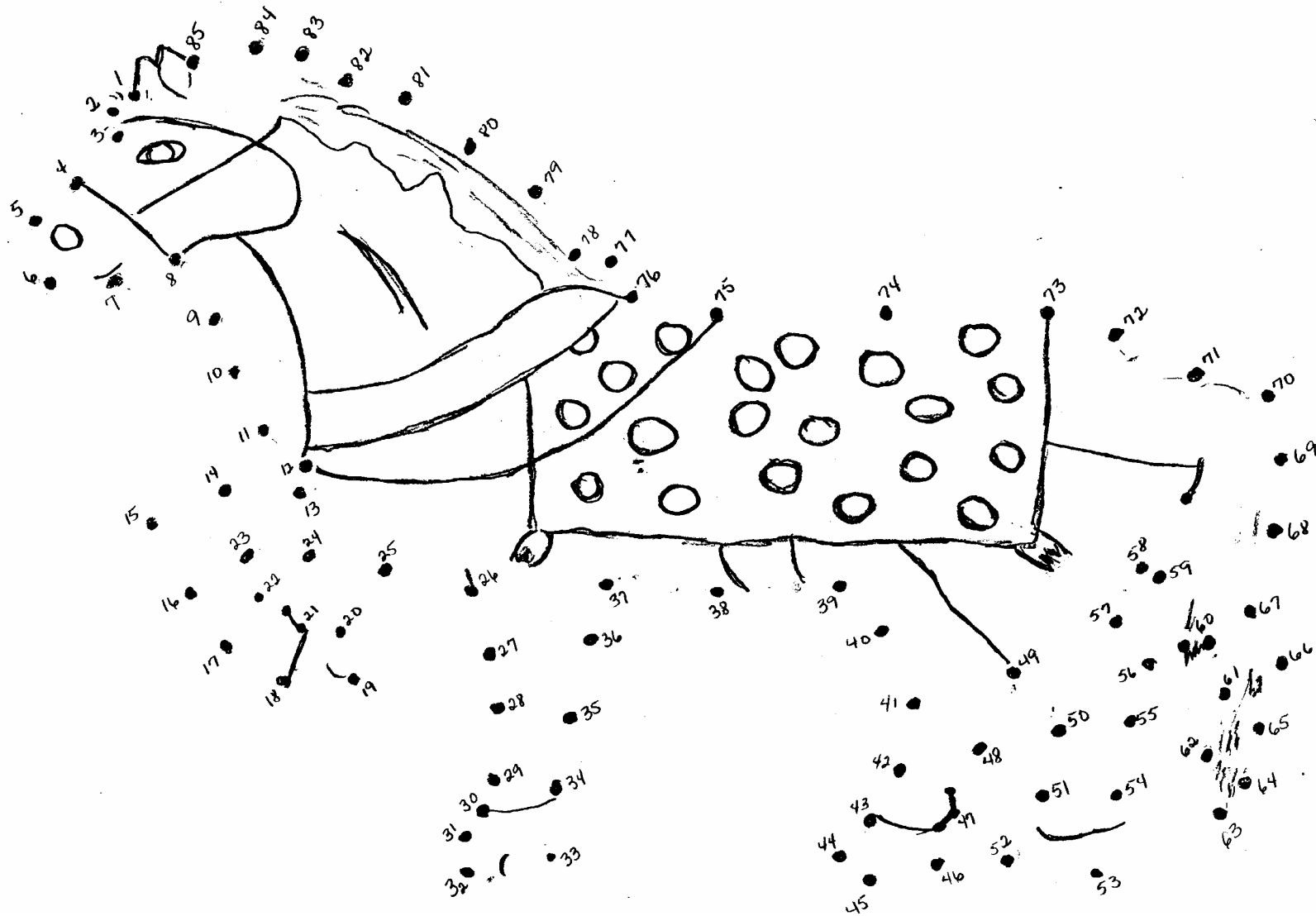
